Fall Clean-Up

Turfmasters soon will begin the front-of-fence fall clean-up. Turfmasters will trim back the Briarwood plantings (Iris, Seedum, Russian Sage). They will divide the plants and plug in gaps. Additionally, they will remove builtup mulch and soil to better align the beds with the sidewalk to reduce run-off.

This work will take time. It is anticipated they will begin on Briarwood Drive.

Homeowners should trim back any other plantings that have been added to the beds, taking care to keep the sidewalk unobstructed.

Homeowners are responsible for trimming and weeding the beds in their landscape. Several properties have overgrown beds and weeds. This concern was raised at the Annual Meeting and will be addressed.
